## Procedure & steps

**1. The new regional CoVE (consisting of at least 1 VET provider/HEI and 1 work field representative) contact the PoVE Water project lead, Pieter Hoekstra and WP2 lead Boudewijn Grievink**

**2. Together, the project lead, wp2 lead and new partners identify:**

1. The needs of the partners in the field of water
  2. How the PoVE Water can help solve those needs
  3. How the PoVE Water and new partners can cocreate solutions for the needs
  4. What the added value and foreseen impact of the collaboration is
- Create an action plan for the upcoming 6 months, outlining tasks, responsibilities and contributions.
  - The PoVE Water funding maps can be used to find additional funding

## What will the new partner get

- Access to the mobility activities in the PoVE Water such as the international water weeks for students.
- Access to the **digital learning materials** in PoVE Water
- Access to the reputation, **recruitment and retainment**
- Invitations to the regional CoVE partner meetings
- Invitations to the Annual International Water Weeks in Leeuwarden and Brno
- The opportunity to work with the other partners on education, applied research, promotion of the water sector and develop new activities, potentially funded by new spin-off projects that build on the network of PoVE Water.
- The partner will be added to the **PoVE Water network map**

## What will the new partner not get

Funding from the current Erasmus PoVE Water Scale up project or the other already running spin-off/ related projects.

- The project lead consults the other regional captains of the PoVE Water about the new partners.
- During a pilot phase of 6 months up to a year, the new partners and PoVE Water work together, evaluating the collaboration afterwards.
- If the evaluation is positive, the new partners will structurally be added to the PoVE Water.

**Legal documents & governance:**

- Depending on the local context, collaboration agreements, letters of intent, memoranda of understanding, consortium agreements can be signed to formalize the collaboration. This is only applicable if the regional setting requires it
- The annual action plans based on the needs in the skills ecosystem are leading in the collaboration in the regional CoVE and the PoVE Water. The new partners can contribute to these action plans and participate.

- The partner can use the communication channels and network of PoVE Water to share relevant news and activities
- After the pilot period, the new partner can use the PoVE Water branding and will be mentioned as a partner on [www.povewater.eu](http://www.povewater.eu)

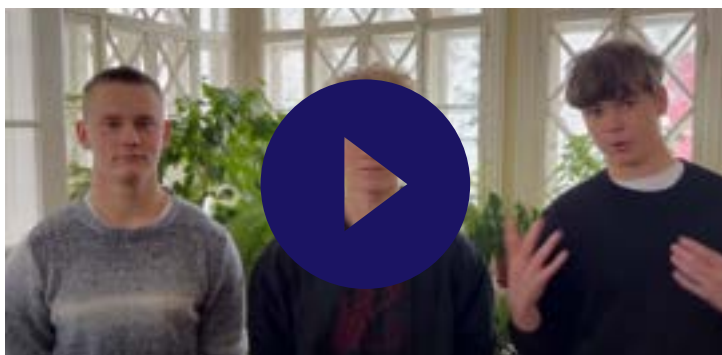
Precondition of the above is active contribution of the new partner, eg. free rider behavior will revoke the abovementioned benefits.
